As the years continue to pass and MIOCA solidifies a reputation of working on behalf of Michigan's ovarian cancer community, I can't help but be in awe of everything that we are accomplishing. Together, we are driving MIOCA's mission. Critical to our success is the fact that we have many individuals, organizations, and businesses joining together to make a difference.

In 2017, MIOCA expanded programs as we focused on our mission of support, education, awareness, advocacy, and research. We offered both support and education to survivors as we hosted our first all-day Survivor Seminar. We were thrilled to introduce our own awareness program, *Tie Michigan Teal*, in which supporters in many cities and towns tied teal ribbons to raise awareness of ovarian cancer in September. Combining awareness and education, we embraced our Teen Initiative. A common misconception is that ovarian cancer is an older woman's disease. Through our teen initiative, we not only worked to reach out to young survivors, but to also inform the public that ovarian cancer does not discriminate by age. Trips to Washington, D.C., and to Lansing allowed Michigan survivors and supporters to meet with legislators. We continue to raise the amount of financial support awarded to innovative researchers here in Michigan. MIOCA's Board was extremely proud to provide \$100,000 in research grants in 2017.

SURVIVOR SEMINAR

In an effort to grow our support of survivors, we greatly expanded on our survivor Meet & Greet by adding an all day educational element. We want to thank Dr. Rebecca Liu, Claire Casselman, and Kara Milliron for generously volunteering their time and sharing their expertise with the survivors in attendance. This seminar provided the opportunity for survivors to learn about topics which are of interest, as well as connect with other women who are traveling a similar journey. On May 6th, 52 women gathered in Ann Arbor for five educational sessions, lunch, and conversation.

MIOCA continues to spread the word about ovarian cancer through our SPEAK program. We are grateful to the survivors who share their stories and put a face to an often misunderstood disease. TIE MICHIGAN TEAL

This year, MIOCA rolled out its new awareness program, *Tie Michigan Teal*. We were excited to create our own program which raised awareness of ovarian cancer and educated others about the symptoms. Through *Tie Michigan Teal*, we are able to focus on MIOCA and the resources which we provide here in Michigan. In 2017, teal ribbons were tied in approximately 35 cities and towns in Michigan. 2017 HIGHLIGHTS

TEEN INITIATIVE

Educating others in Michigan is critical because there is no early detection test for ovarian cancer. In 2017, MIOCA embraced its Teen Initiative. Our goal was to educate others about the fact that ovarian cancer affects females of all ages. To this end, MIOCA found opportunities for young survivors to talk about their diagnoses and treatments on the radio and television. A SPEAK presentation was held for a university Human Sexuality course. Over 3000 brochures were sent to various high schools in MI to distribute as part of health class. We have highlighted the fact that ovarian cancer does not age discriminate at our awareness events. It was perfect that Dr. Hope Haefner, Professor, University of Michigan Hospitals, Dept. of Obstetrics and Gynecology and a member of MIOCA's Medical Advisory Board spoke at MIOCA's Year End Celebration. Dr. Haefner was diagnosed as a child and will soon celebrate the 50th anniversary of her ovarian cancer diagnosis in May of 1968. Our UM student affiliate, Next Gen, held an educational event in December. We are so appreciative of the members of Next Gen as they work on UM's campus to raise awareness and educate.

COMMUNITY PARTNER – OCRFA

Once again this year, there were great opportunities to join with others from across the country at Ovarian Cancer Research Fund Alliance events.

In March, MIOCA paid to send Michigan women to the National Ovarian Cancer Advocacy Day in Washington, D.C. There, we met with several Michigans legislators to discuss the importance of continued funding of ovarian cancer research and other programs designed to raise awareness and educate the public.

Later in the year, several survivors traveled to Chicago to participate in the Ovarian Cancer National Conference. MIOCA provided grants to cover travel as well as opportunities to network with other Michigan survivors.

GERI FOURNIER OVARIAN CANCER RESEARCH GRANTS

It was with great excitement that MIOCA announced the 2017 Geri Fournier Ovarian Cancer Research Award Recipients. Due to the increasing support of MIOCA, its Board of Directors, once again, increased the funds dedicated to ovarian cancer research here in Michigan. A total of \$100,000 funded two Michigan researchers working to improve treatment outcomes.

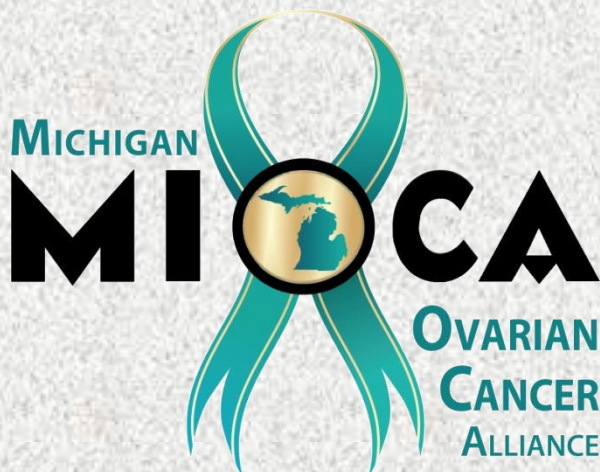

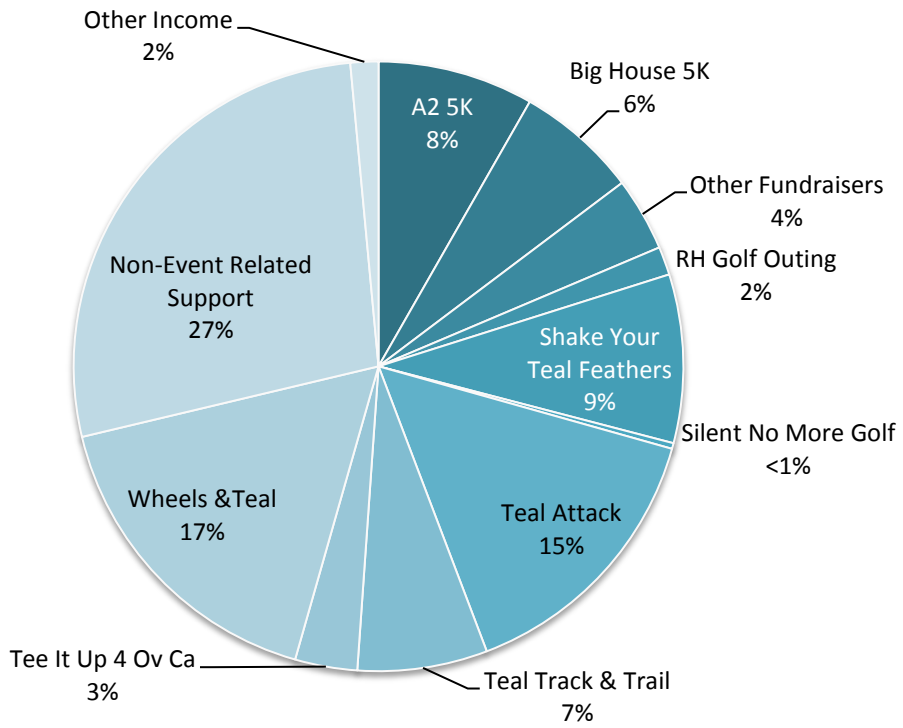

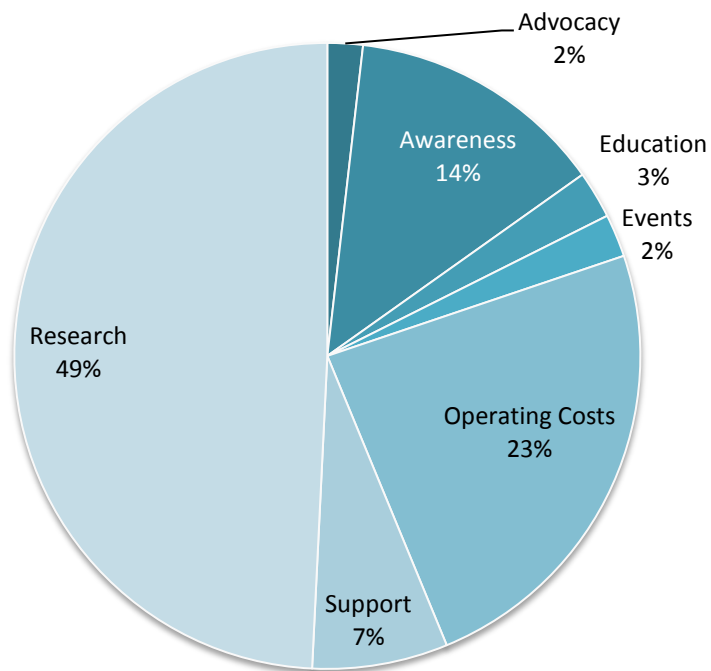
