My name is Karen O'Brien, and I'm reaching out in hopes that you will agree to participate in our Teal Attack initiative this season. In 2021, I retired from coaching volleyball, after a 40-year coaching career. I also received news that I would have to undergo yet another round of chemotherapy for my fifth recurrence of ovarian cancer. I am glad to share that I am now 18 months cancer free.

As coaches, we encourage our players to work hard, and work together, towards a common goal. That is what I am asking you to do: join my team and help support ovarian cancer fighters and survivors like me. Because the game is always on the line when it comes to fighting cancer, and we need all of the help we can get.

Since 2015, we have held over 130 Teal Attack events and raised upwards of \$500,000 for the Michigan Ovarian Cancer Alliance (MIOCA). In 2023, Teal Attack was recognized nationally through Scientific America's Cancer Community Awards and Sports Imports/AVCA Courage Award.

The ask is simple and free: designate one home game during your upcoming season as a "Teal Attack" game. That's it. All I need from you is a date and we will take it from there. There is no cost or minimum fundraising requirement to participate. Just a request to do whatever you can to help me in my efforts to support MIOCA in our collective fight against ovarian cancer.
