TOTE PROGRAM

This year, MIOCA's team sent **46 support totes** containing comfort items, resources and helpful information to individuals across Michigan who received an ovarian cancer diagnosis or experienced a recurrence.

EDUCATION

In 2022, MIOCA offered education opportunities via webinars on making meaning & sharing your story, reading food labels, cooking while in treatment and fitness for increased strength and mobility. Classes were hosted online and free to join.

SUPPORT GROUPS

Through 2022, MIOCA hosted monthly survivor support groups to help meet the needs of individuals diagnosed with ovarian cancer. Our *West Michigan Support Network*, facilitated by Katie Barcelona, LLMSW, *Teal Sisters Support Network*, facilitated by Maneesha Finkle, LMSW, and *Younger Survivor Support Network*, facilitated by Valerie Paige, M.A., LLPC helped to provide comfort, conversation and support to those facing ovarian cancer. We also partnered with Munson Healthcare for their Northern Michigan group.

Thank you to the **Donald R. and Esther Simon Foundation** for supporting MIOCA's survivor programming through their \$17,000 grant awarded in 2021 which continues to aid our support group expansion and development.

MIOCA is grateful to have received a generous grant from the **Rodger and Kate Graef Family Foundation** for the creation and translation of resources in multiple languages to support greater access to information about ovarian cancer across Michigan.

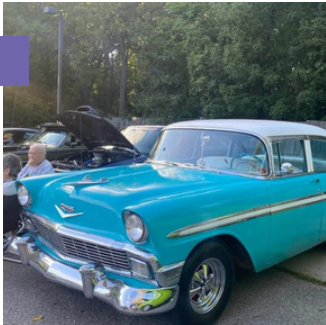
COMMUNITY FUNDRAISERS

The annual **Teal Attack Golf Outing** was hosted at Dundee Golf Club on September 17th. With games, an auction and more, the event raised **\$12,773**.

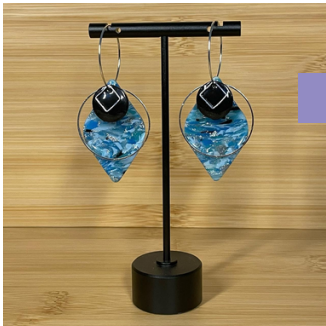

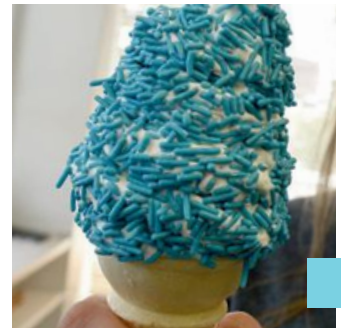

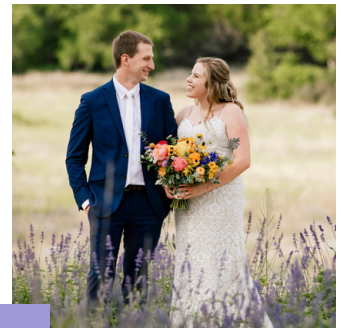

SPEAK

Through MIOCA's SPEAK and OCRA's Survivors Teaching Students programs, patients and survivors tell their stories to raise ovarian cancer awareness and increase the public's understanding of its symptoms.

In 2022, members of SPEAK presented at Gilda's Club of Royal Oak, Shelby Township Community Center and virtually at General Motors' Lunch & Learn event. These presentations drew in more than 500 people across the state.

As statewide facilitators of the Survivors Teaching Students® Program of the Ovarian Cancer Research Alliance, MIOCA teams educated future healthcare professionals (i.e., medical, nursing, or other allied health professional students) through presentations at 17 schools reaching 700 students.

ATTACK**

Founded by Karen O’Brien in 2015, the Teal Attack movement engages high school and collegiate athletic programs to increase awareness across age groups about ovarian cancer and raise funds in support of the mission of MIOCA. To date, over 100 Teal Attack events have been held and upwards of \$375k has been raised by communities across the state.

TEAL 10 CONCERT

On Friday, July 15, 2022, MIOCA hosted Teal 10, a concert for ovarian cancer awareness at Jean Klock Park Pavilion in Benton Harbor. This free event offered education and entertainment to a historically underserved West Michigan community and brought together citizens and local business owners to hear stories, find resources and dance the night away on Lake Michigan.

RESEARCH

Since 2014, MIOCA has provided **\$750,000** to researchers in Michigan who are finding new ways to improve the treatment of ovarian cancer. The Geri Fournier Ovarian Cancer Research Award, named for MIOCA's co-founder, was created to recognize and provide funding for the critical research happening in the state of Michigan.

In 2022, MIOCA was pleased to award our \$50,000 research grant to Dr. Gen Sheng Wu for his study on targeting PARP inhibitor resistance in ovarian cancer.

Dr. Wu is a Professor in the Department of Oncology and Pathology at the Wayne State University School of Medicine. His research interest involves the resistance of cancer cells to chemotherapies, with particular attention to breast and ovarian cancers.

This project aims to understand the mechanism of resistance to PARP inhibitors. PARP inhibitors are currently used for treating patients with ovarian cancer but developing resistance to PARP inhibitors is a clinical problem.

Dr. Wu and his team are investigating how ATG5, a protein that mediates cellular substrate degradation, promotes PARP inhibitor resistance. Identifying the mechanism will help provide a new strategy to improve the treatment of epithelial ovarian cancer.



ADVOCACY

Part of MIOCA's mission is to advance federal and state legislation to increase funding for ovarian cancer research, awareness and support for survivors. In March 2022, participants took to Capitol Hill virtually for Ovarian Cancer Advocacy Day, coordinated by the Ovarian Cancer Research Alliance (OCRA). Members of MIOCA's staff and board joined advocates across the state and met with legislative staff and urged them to make ovarian cancer research and education programs a congressional priority.

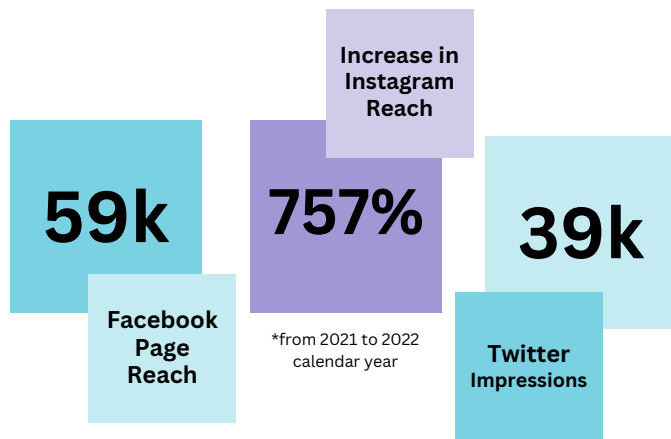

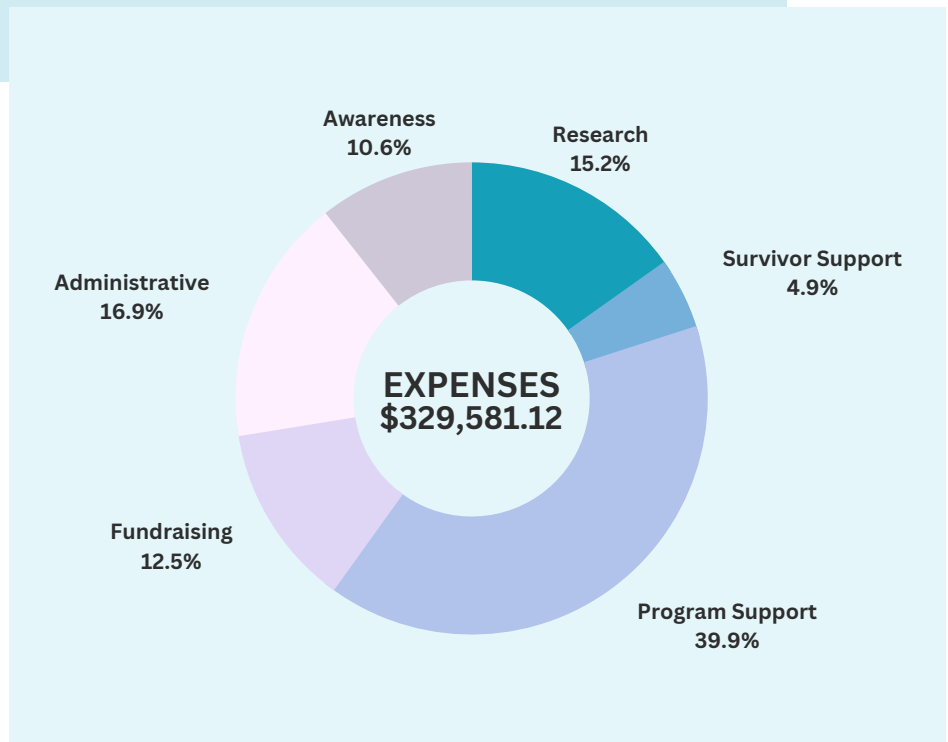
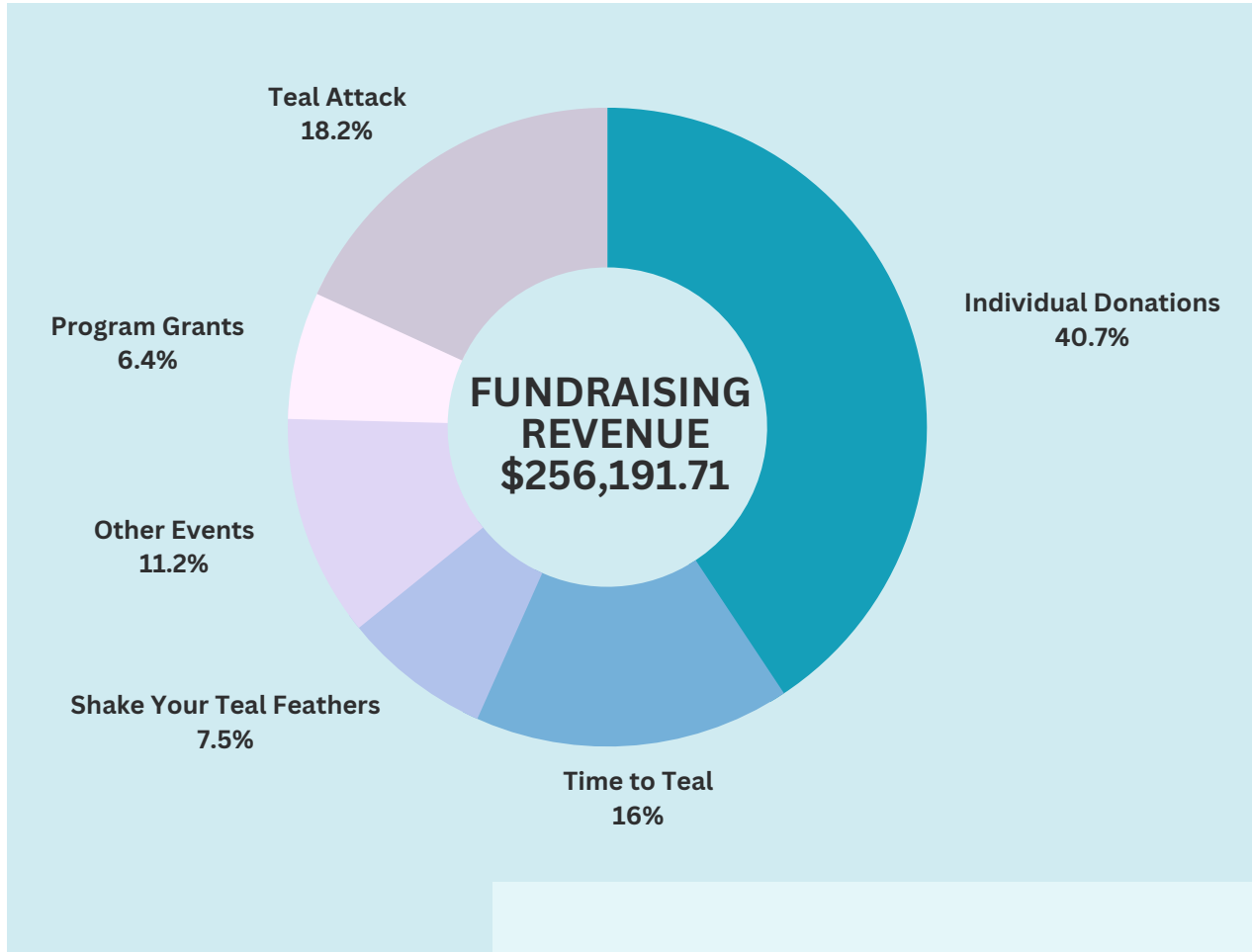
