## SUPPORT TOTES

This year, MIOCA's team sent **77 support totes** containing resources, comfort items, handmade gifts and letters of support to individuals across Michigan who received an ovarian cancer diagnosis or experienced a recurrence. Compared to the 46 totes delivered in 2022, we are proud to be reaching more individuals who can use our services. Special thanks to Jan Potts who coordinated this program from 2019 through 2023 and provided great care and support for survivors.

## SUPPORT GROUPS

Through 2023, MIOCA hosted monthly survivor support groups to help meet the needs of individuals diagnosed with ovarian cancer. Our West Michigan Support Network, facilitated by Katie Barcelona, LLMSW, Teal Sisters Support Network, facilitated by Maneesha Finkle, LMSW, and Younger Survivor Support Network, facilitated by Valerie Paige, M.A., LLPC helped to provide comfort, conversation and support to those facing ovarian cancer.

We want to thank the Donald R. and Esther Simon Foundation for supporting MIOCA's survivor programming through their \$17,000 grant awarded in 2021 which continues to aid our support group expansion and development.

**New in 2023**, we launched a *Friends & Family* support group which was designed for loved ones of ovarian cancer survivors to have space to share connection and support with one another.

We recognize that helping others through a cancer journey can be challenging and speaking to others about one's experiences can be beneficial.

Spouses, partners, family members and friends who have a loved one with ovarian cancer are encouraged to join the conversation via our monthly meetings.

## EDUCATION

In 2023, MIOCA co-hosted free interactive webinars and events to educate and support the members of our community. Virtual meetings were held throughout the year including:

- *Navigating a Gynecologic Cancer Diagnosis* with Wisconsin Ovarian Cancer Alliance & others
- *Nutrition 101* with Gilda's Club Grand Rapids
- *Managing Side Effects of Ovarian Cancer Treatment* with ApricityCare
- *Fitness for Cancer Fatigue* with Champ Therapy & Wellness

MIOCA also partnered with nurse writers for articles addressing cancer & mental health, breaking the news of a diagnosis, and talking to kids about cancer. Thank you to writers, Shannon Scorzelli, DNP, APRN, FNP-BC & Becky Zook, RN, BSN, MS.

And in October, we co-hosted the inaugural Ovarian Cancer Research Symposium in partnership with CS Mott Center for Human Growth & Development in Detroit.

## RESOURCES

In 2023, MIOCA continued to update, translate and produce awareness materials in Spanish and Arabic languages. This was made possible through the ongoing support of the Rodger and Kate Graef Family Foundation grant. The creation of these materials aims to enhance access to vital information about ovarian cancer throughout Michigan.



# RESEARCH

Since 2014, MIOCA has provided \$800,000 to researchers in Michigan who are finding new ways to improve the treatment of ovarian cancer. The Geri Fournier Ovarian Cancer Research Award, named for MIOCA's co-founder, was created to recognize and provide funding for the critical research happening in the state of Michigan.

In 2023, MIOCA was pleased to award our \$50,000 research grant to Ramesh Babu Batchu, M.Phil., Ph.D., Wayne State University School of Medicine for his study on *Targeting Unshed Mesothelin and the PD-1 Immune Checkpoint Pathway with Chimeric Antigen Receptor T Cells for the Treatment of Ovarian Cancer*.

Dr. Batchu specializes in immuno-gene therapy with a focus on pancreatic and ovarian cancers. His study further examines chimeric antigen receptor (CAR) modified T lymphocytes known as CAR T cells. Due to the high success rate with non-solid cancer cells and in the laboratory against ovarian cancer cells, Dr. Batchu and his team are exploring how to successfully move the therapy from the bench to the bedside.

We look forward to learning the results of Dr. Batchu's very important research, which has potential to improve treatment options for those facing ovarian cancer.



# TEAL ATTACK

In 2023, 40 schools participated in Teal Attack games, raising crucial awareness among approximately 1,200 student athletes plus their families and friends. The 2023 Teal Attack golf outing was one of the year's most significant fundraisers.

Founded by Karen O'Brien in 2015, the Teal Attack movement engages student athletic programs to increase awareness & raise funds in support of MIOCA's mission. To date, the program has raised nearly \$470k.

Teal Attack founder Karen O'Brien was recognized nationally in October 2023 by the Cancer Community Awards where she won the award for Unconventional Hero. The award, presented by AstraZeneca in partnership with Scientific American, recognizes the unexpected people or organizations changing oncology through unique avenues and for winning, Karen received a \$50,000 grant for MIOCA programming.

Karen was also awarded Sports Imports and AVCA's 2023 Courage Award which recognizes a member of the volleyball community who faced adversity and displayed courage to use the experience to better the world around them.

## SURVIVORS TEACHING STUDENTS®

Statewide participants of the Ovarian Cancer Research Alliance’s Survivors Teaching Students® program helped to educate future healthcare providers about ovarian cancer by sharing stories of diagnosis, treatment and survivorship, along with facts about the disease.

In 2023, 25 participants presented at approximately 17 medical education programs across 7 schools and universities in Michigan. This outreach effort successfully reached 491 aspiring healthcare professionals, delivering crucial messages about ovarian cancer. We hope that these messages will resonate with the students and guide them in their future careers, contributing to better awareness and care in the field of healthcare.

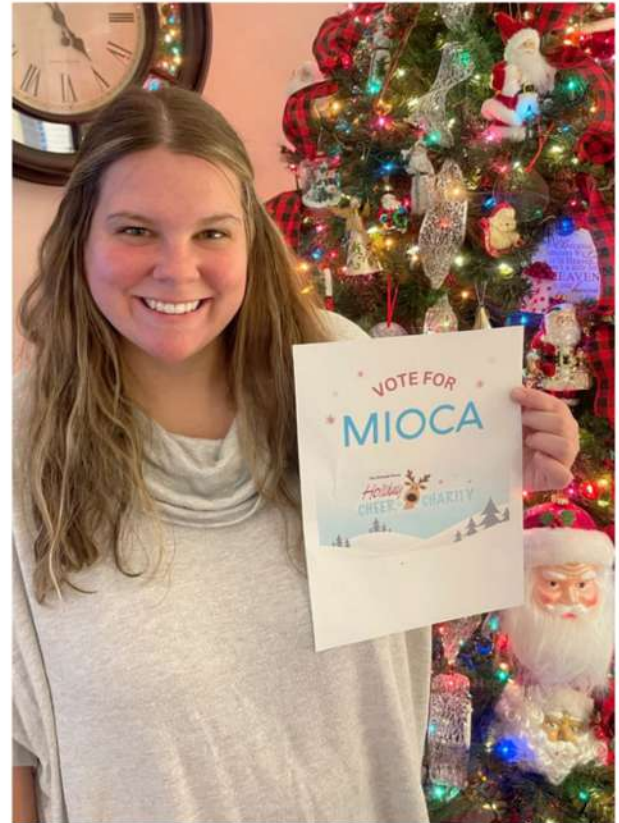


# AWARENESS

Part of MIOCA's mission is to advance federal and state legislation to increase funding for ovarian cancer research, awareness and support for survivors. In March 2023, participants took to Capitol Hill virtually for Ovarian Cancer Advocacy Day, coordinated by the Ovarian Cancer Research Alliance (OCRA). Members of our Michigan advocate network joined others across the country to meet with legislative staff and urge them to make ovarian cancer research and education programs a congressional priority.

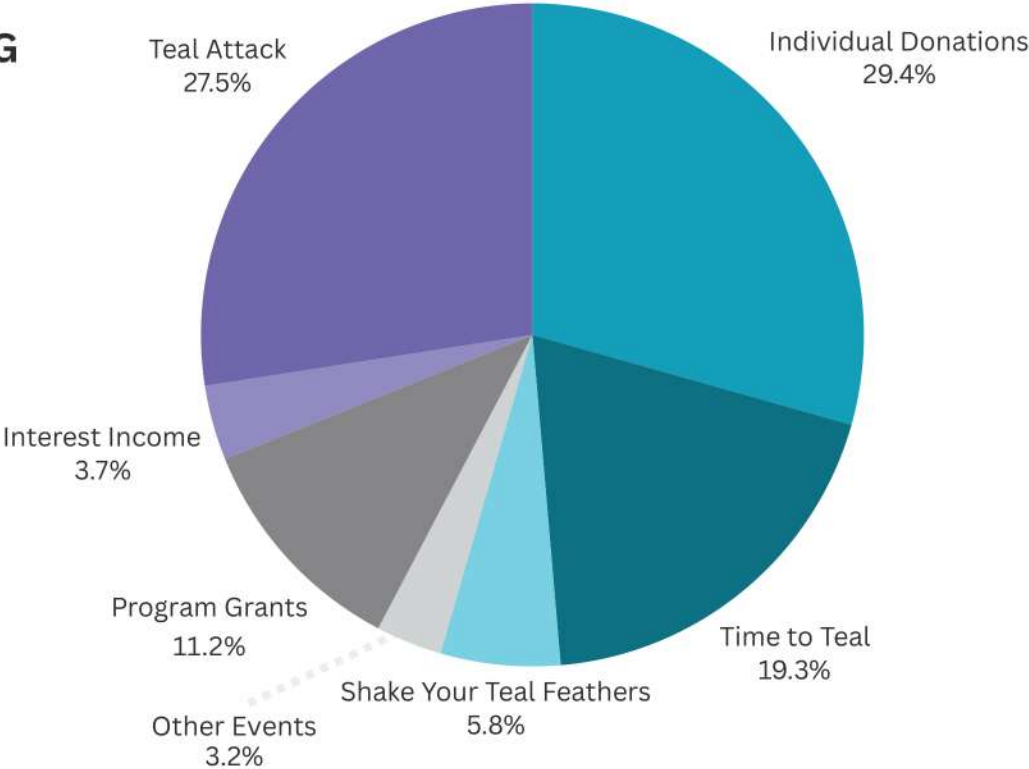
Advocacy efforts play a critical role as individuals who have been impacted by ovarian cancer share lived experiences to educate legislators on initiatives needed to advance access, awareness and care.

And in 2023, thanks to advocacy efforts made by groups across the states, **Oral Chemo Fairness** legislation was signed into law in October. Initially introduced in Michigan over 15 years ago, this legislation finally gives patients more affordable access to cancer treatment regardless of how drugs are administered. This is a big step forward and we're grateful to the advocates who helped make it happen.

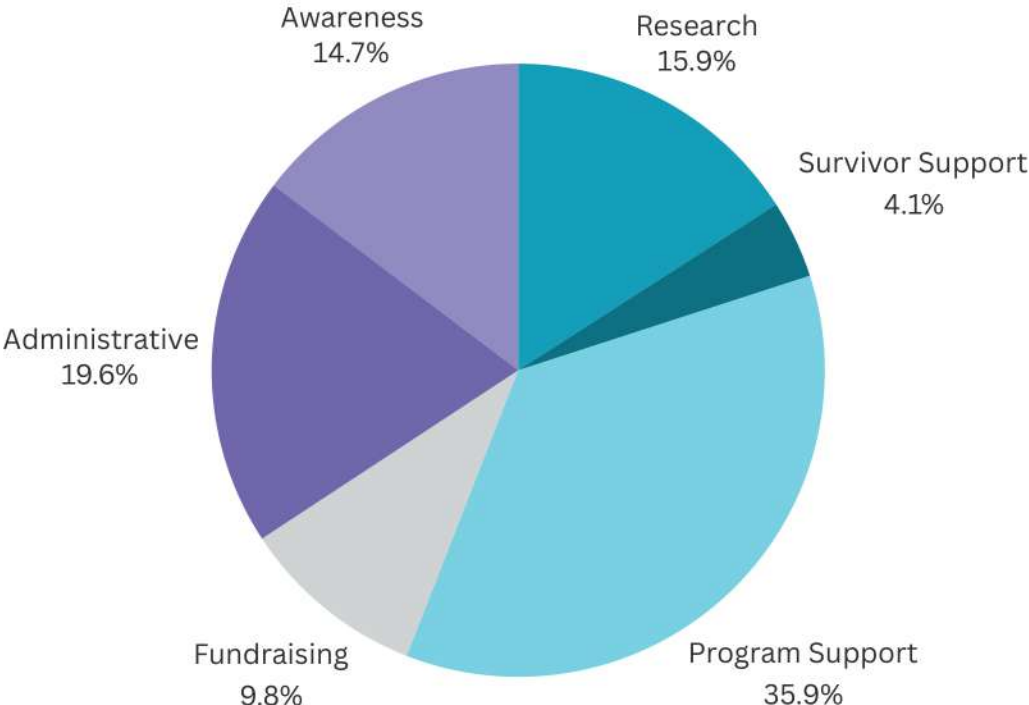
