PROGRAMS

Support Totes

In 2025, MIOCA provided 60 support totes to individuals throughout Michigan who were newly diagnosed with ovarian cancer or facing a recurrence. Each tote was thoughtfully assembled with educational resources, comfort items, handmade gifts, a small gas card, and personal notes to offer support and connection with the MIOCA community. The tote program remains an important part of MIOCA's commitment to ensuring that individuals across the state do not face ovarian cancer alone but rather have access to meaningful resources, compassionate support, and reliable information throughout treatment and beyond.

Support Groups

Throughout 2025, MIOCA continued to provide monthly virtual support groups tailored to the needs of individuals and families impacted by ovarian cancer. Through the Friends and Family Support Network, the Teal Sisters Support Network, and the Younger Survivor Support Network, participants found opportunities for connection, encouragement, and shared understanding in a supportive environment. Throughout the year, there were approximately 115 interactions across the three groups. Together, these groups offered compassionate support and meaningful conversation for individuals navigating the challenges of ovarian cancer at every stage of the journey.

EDUCATION

Survivor Events

MIOCA aims to create meaningful opportunities for connection, education, and support through survivor-focused activities. Our Survivor Retreat brought together survivors from across the state for educational presentations, expert-led discussions, and speaker panels that provided valuable information. We also hosted an in-person Paint-Along event, offering a relaxed and creative space for survivors to connect with one another.

Partnerships

We strengthened our impact through partnerships with organizations including Cancer + Careers, Triage Cancer, Karmanos Cancer Institute, and Ina® to provide educational webinars and resources. This year, MIOCA also partnered to host a Family Building for Ovarian Cancer Survivors webinar, offering information for those exploring family-building options after diagnosis and treatment. In addition, MIOCA is a participating partner in presenting programs for Navigating an Gynecologic Cancer Diagnosis webinar.

RESEARCH

MIOCA remains committed to advancing ovarian cancer research that drives innovation in early detection, treatment, and patient outcomes. Since 2014, the organization has invested in groundbreaking scientific efforts through the Geri Fournier Ovarian Cancer Research Grant, supporting researchers across Michigan who are working to improve the future of ovarian cancer care.

Named in honor of MIOCA co-founder Geri Fournier, the Geri Fournier Ovarian Cancer Research Award was established to encourage and support impactful research taking place within our state. This important funding opportunity is made possible through the generosity and dedication of our donors and supporters, whose commitment continues to fuel progress in ovarian cancer research.

In 2025, MIOCA was honored to award a \$50,000 research grant to Dr. Principal Investigator Abdulsalam Soofi, PhD, at the University of Michigan for the project, “Pax2/Pax8 Deficiency–Induced Epithelial Stress and Transformation as Biomarker Pathways for Early Ovarian Cancer Detection”.

Dr. Soofi’s study investigates how changes in two proteins, known as Pax2 and Pax8, may cause stress within cells and trigger early transformation events that precede cancer development. These early cellular changes may occur long before cancer is detectable. By identifying these signals, Dr. Soofi’s research aims to help lay the foundation for more precise screening tools and earlier diagnosis of ovarian cancer.

We look forward to following the progress and outcomes of this important work and the potential it holds in working toward earlier detection of ovarian cancer. Dr. Soofi is a biomedical researcher in the Department of Internal Medicine at Michigan Medicine.

Mother's Day 5K & Fun Run

MIOCA proudly hosted our 14th annual Mother's Day Time to Teal 5K & Fun Run on Sunday, May 11th, 2025. This event brought together supporters in downtown Ann Arbor and virtually across the state to celebrate the incredible women in our lives while raising awareness of ovarian cancer. Participants joined a timed 5K or 1-mile fun run/walk, with both in-person and "Stay Home for a Cure" options available.

A total of 739 participants registered for Time to Teal, including 44 ovarian cancer survivors, whose registration was free.

New for 2025, MIOCA hosted an online auction leading up to race day featuring items generously provided by in-kind donors. The auction created an additional opportunity for community engagement and fundraising. Event merchandise was also available for purchase onsite, & event shirts were offered as an optional add-on during registration. We are deeply grateful to our sponsors, donors, fundraisers, volunteers, and participants for making this year's event such a meaningful success. Together, \$73,400 was raised to support MIOCA.

Shake Your Teal Feathers

Our Shake Your Teal Feathers: Sundae Stroll was held on Sunday, September 28, 2025, at The Meadows of Millennium Park in Grand Rapids. This family-friendly ovarian cancer awareness event brought together the community for a 1-mile walk/run through the park's scenic trails in support of those impacted by ovarian cancer. Following the walk, participants enjoyed ice cream at the finish line, along with a raffle and silent auction that added to the day's celebration and fundraising efforts.

A total of 219 participants joined the event, including 19 ovarian cancer survivors, whose registration was free of charge this year. Event shirts were also available as an optional add-on purchase during registration. We extend our sincere gratitude to our sponsors, donors, fundraisers, participants, and volunteers for their generosity & continued support in making this event memorable. The event raised \$15,400 to support MIOCA.

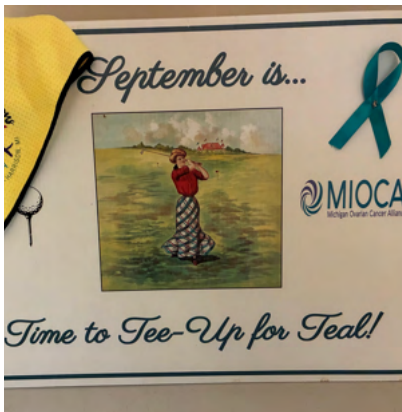
Purse Bingo

FUNDRAISING

Detroit Marathon

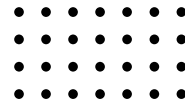

These meaningful funds help us continue advancing our mission and expanding support, education, and awareness efforts for individuals and families impacted by ovarian cancer.

Giving Tuesday

For Giving Tuesday, MIOCA launched Turn Giving Tuesday Teal, an online campaign centered on bringing greater visibility to ovarian cancer. Through social media posts and email outreach, supporters were encouraged to help spread awareness & support MIOCA through donations, with a matching gift opportunity.



Teal Attack

In 2025, MIOCA's Teal Attack program continued to expand its impact across Michigan communities. A total of 14 Teal Attack events were held throughout the year, with 33 teams participating in Teal Attack games that helped raise awareness among more than 495 student athletes, along with their families, friends, and supporters.

The annual Teal Attack Golf Outing in Dundee remained one of the organization's most successful fundraising events of the year. Collectively, Teal Attack teams and supporters raised more than \$33,000 to further MIOCA's mission of supporting those affected by ovarian cancer through education, advocacy, research, and support services.

Founded in 2015 by Karen O'Brien, the Teal Attack movement partners with student athletic programs to increase ovarian cancer awareness while generating critical funding for MIOCA's programs and initiatives. Since its inception, Teal Attack has raised more than \$560,000 in support of MIOCA's mission and continues to inspire communities across the state to take action and make a difference.

Tie Michigan Teal

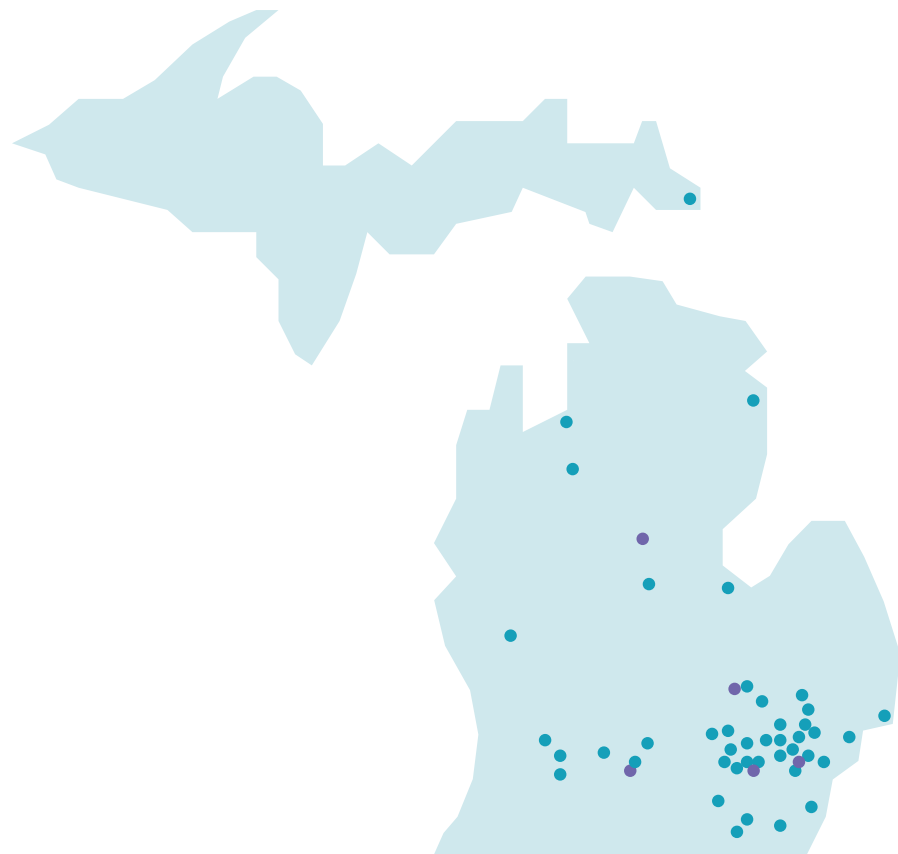
In 2025, 52 cities and 5 college campuses across Michigan participated in this program.

Survivor Presentations

Through MIOCA's SPEAK: Survivors Promoting Early Awareness and Knowledge and the Ovarian Cancer Research Alliance's Survivors Teaching Students® programs, survivors shared their stories to raise ovarian cancer awareness, increase recognition, and expand the public's understanding of its symptoms. As statewide facilitators of the Survivors Teaching Students® Program, survivors educated future healthcare professionals in 2025, including medical, nursing, and allied health students. Throughout the year, 14 volunteer speakers delivered 24 presentations, reaching 712 students. Volunteers also led two SPEAK presentations that provided vital ovarian cancer information to community members.

In addition, thanks to the generous support of the Kiwanis Club of Ann Arbor, MIOCA was able to host a Student Networking Night featuring presentations by survivors and professionals, creating an opportunity for students to learn, ask questions, and connect with individuals working in healthcare and patient support.



ADVOCACY

Advocacy is a key part of MIOCA's mission to support individuals, families, and communities impacted by ovarian cancer, particularly through efforts to increase funding for ovarian cancer research, awareness, and survivor support programs.

Throughout the year, members of MIOCA's network participate in a variety of activities to highlight the importance of ovarian cancer research, awareness, and education programs with policymakers. Advocacy efforts play a critical role in advancing access, awareness, and care, as individuals impacted by ovarian cancer share their lived experiences to help educate legislators about initiatives and resources needed to improve outcomes for patients and survivors.

Our work would not be possible without the dedication of our volunteers, who generously give their time and talents throughout the year. 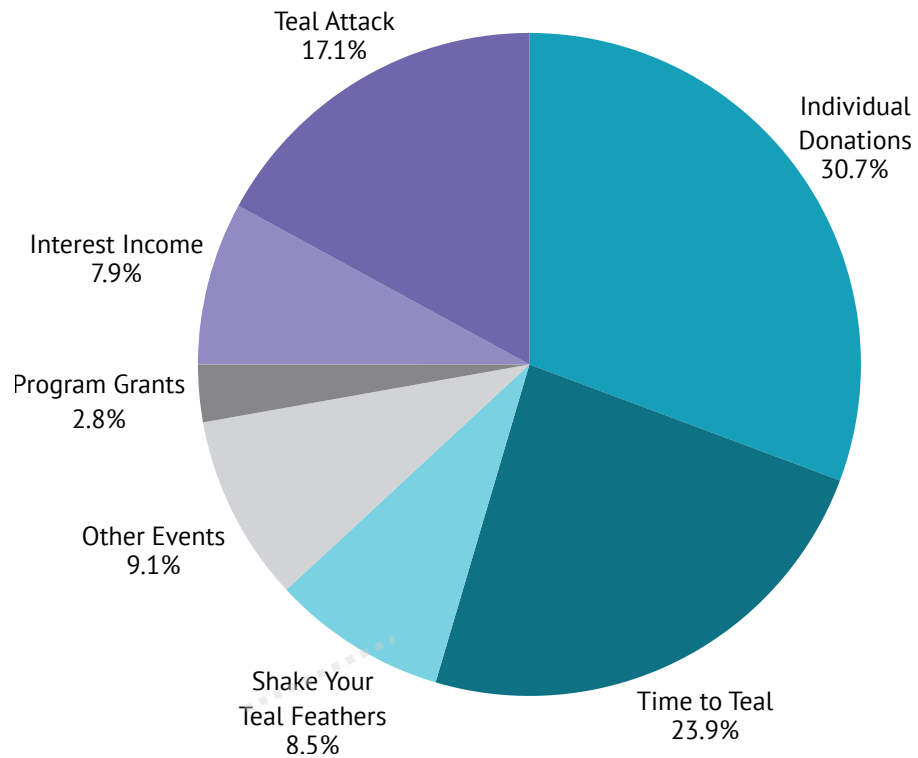

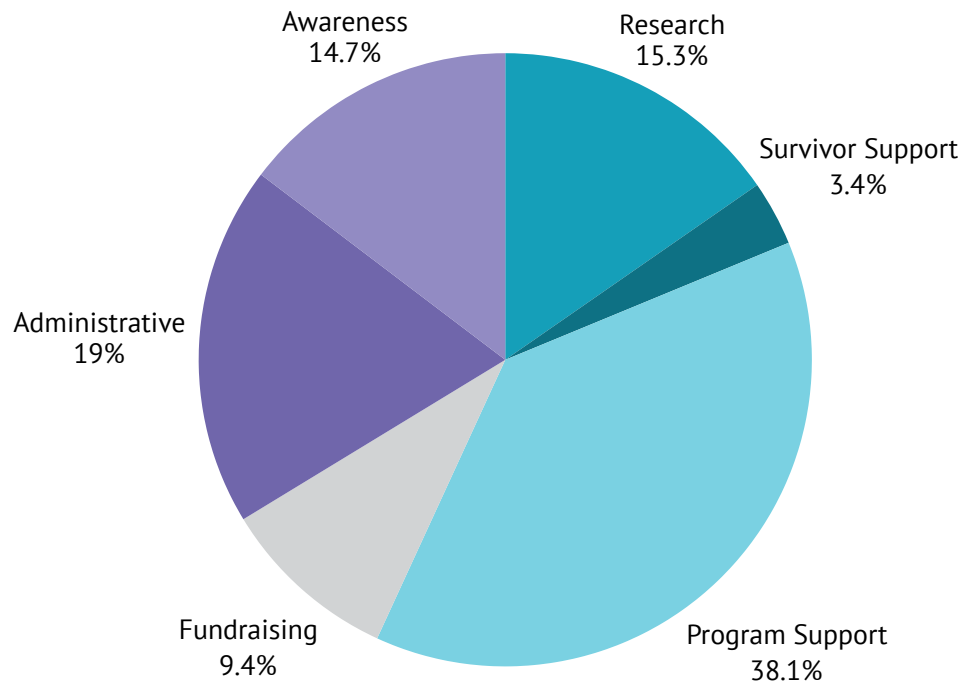
